Create Hedgehog Highways

Help out a hog and link your gardens!

- Did you know that hedgehogs travel around one mile every night! One of the main reasons why hedgehogs are declining in the UK is because our fences and walls are becoming more and more secure, reducing the amount of land available to them and their ability to find enough food and a mate
- Our neighbourhoods can help hedgehogs by creating a network of suitable holes in our garden fences, 13cm by 13cm is sufficient for any hedgehog to pass through and this is too small for nearly all pets
- Options include: Removing a brick from the bottom of the wall; cutting a small hole in your fence if there are no gaps; digging a channel underneath your wall, fence or gate
